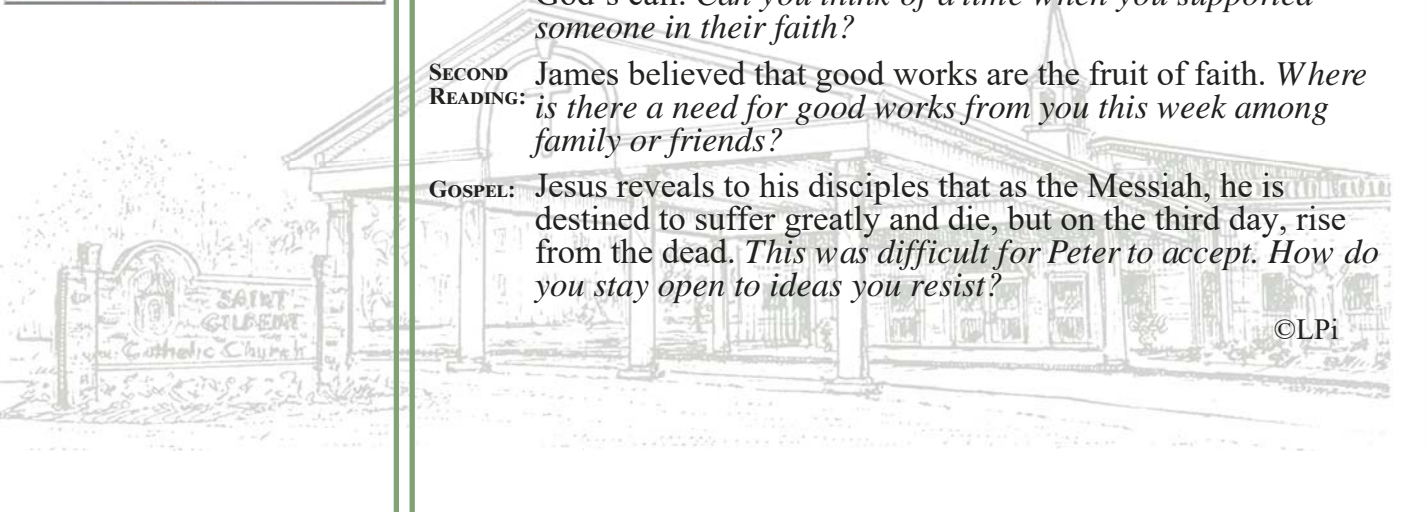


**FIRST READING:** Isaiah stands firm in his faith as he suffered in following God's call. *Can you think of a time when you supported someone in their faith?*

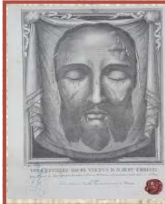

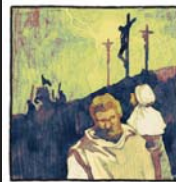

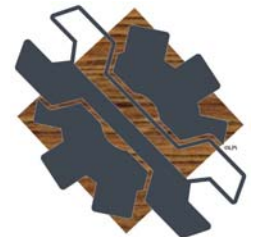

## Saint Gilbert Facility Improvement Projects—

1. The Village of Grayslake is mandating lead testing of water. The testing alone is \$2,600 and if there are elevated levels of lead, the correction pricing is yet to be determined.

2. We are replacing 6 sidewalk squares outside of the rectory and chapel. They have degraded enough to be trip hazards to those walking on them.
