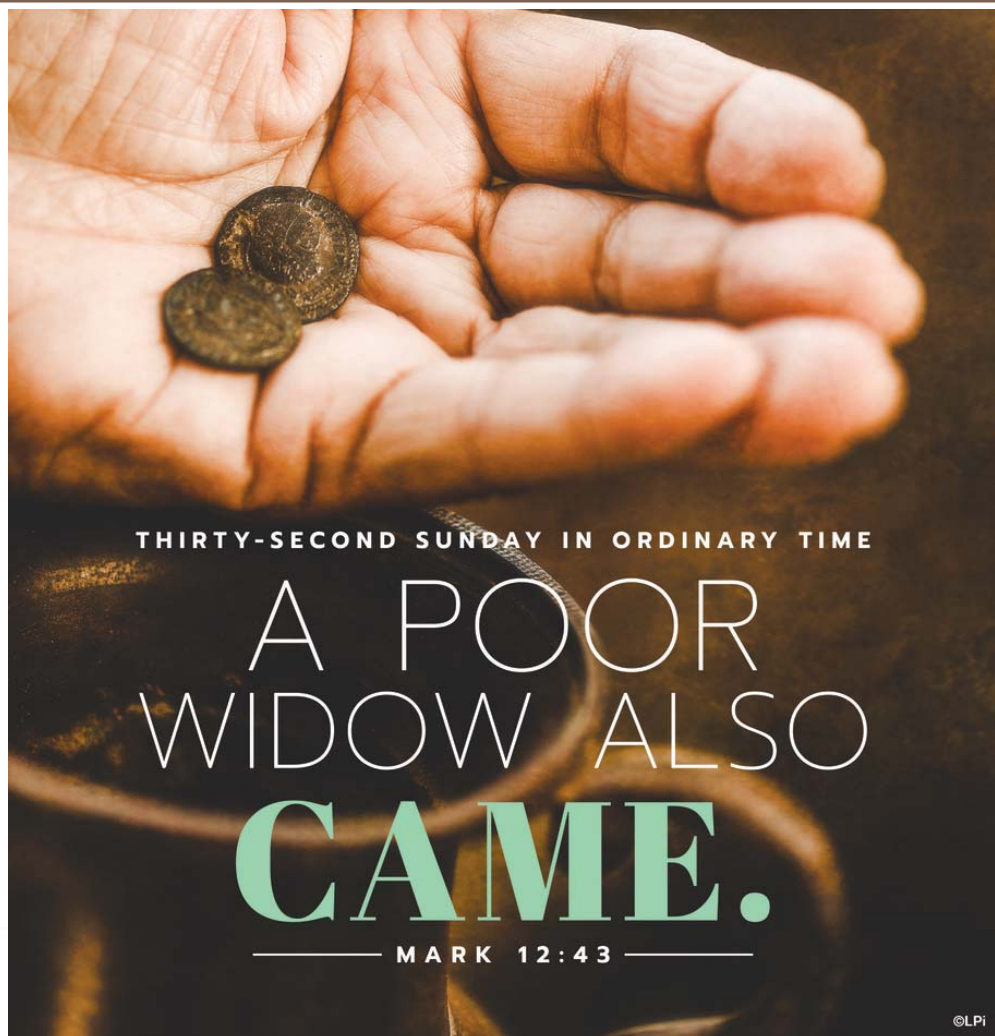

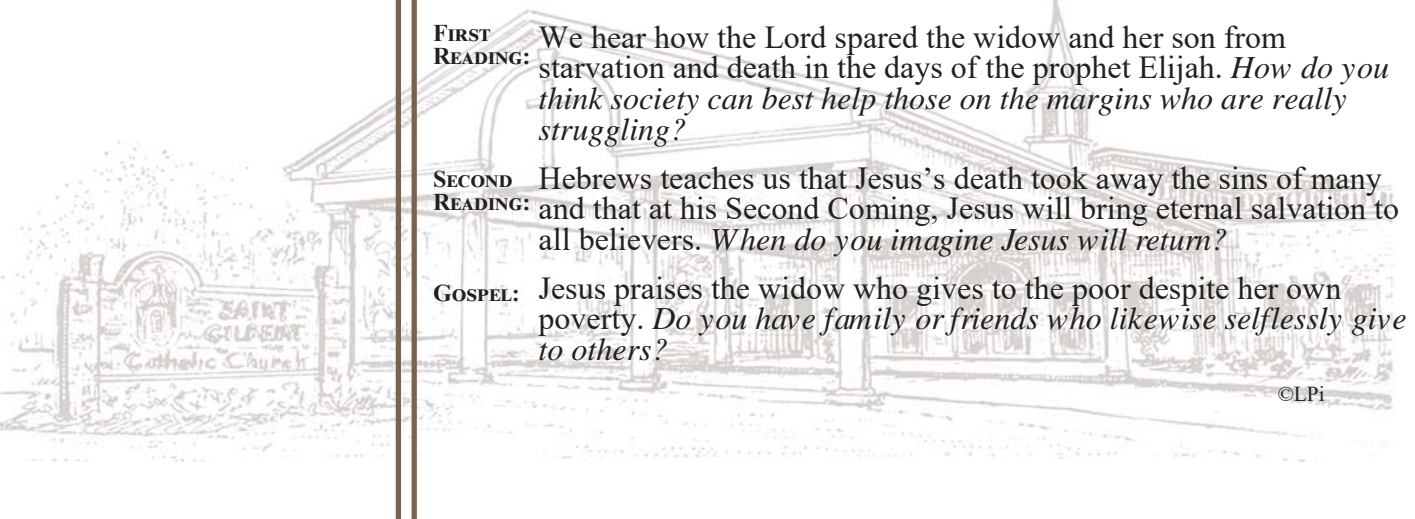

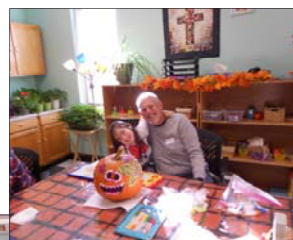

Stade's Farm provided pumpkins for the students in SPRED which the students decorated. Pictures are from that activity. Thanks to Stade's Farm for their donation.

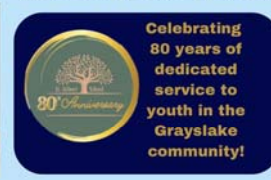

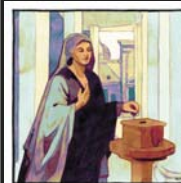

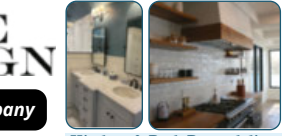
