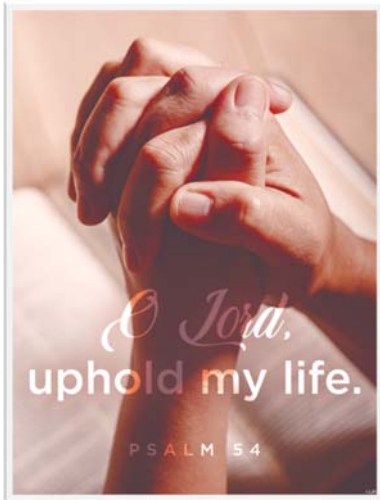

SR. DONNA SCHMITT'S 60TH JUBILEE

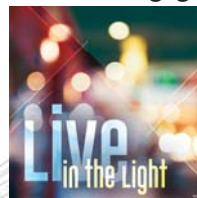
Come Live in the Light



Donna Schmitt joined the congregation of the Sisters of St. Francis in Dubuque, Iowa in 1963 as a postulant. Having answered the call to a religious vocation, Sister Donna has been living in the light. She recently celebrated her 60th Jubilee at Mount St. Francis Center in Dubuque on the 23rd of June, 2024. Sister Donna has served in a number of ministries over the course of her religious life:

- †(1979 – 1980) Teacher and REP Coordinator at St. Mary's Parish in Cascade, Iowa.
- †(1980 – 1983) Sacrament Coordinator at St. Marcelline Catholic Parish in Schaumburg, Illinois.
- †(1983 – 1984) Director of Religious Education (DRE) at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Downers Grove, Illinois.
- †(1984 – 1996) DRE at St. John Brebeuf Parish in Niles, Illinois.
- †(1996 – 1999) Pastoral Associate at St. Jude Catholic Church in Louisa, Kentucky.
- †(1999 – Present) DRE at St. Gilbert Parish in Grayslake, Illinois.

Sister Donna has been serving selflessly the faith community at St. Gilbert Parish since 1999. It is through her prayer, efforts, and countless hours of dedicated work that the Religious Education Program (REP) and SPRED program have flourished, and vibrant ministries such as Rejoice in God, Bereavement Program, Breaking Open the Word, and Family Program continue to involve parishioners. She also heads the Tolson Teaching Parish Program (TTPP) through which certain parish members engage with the seminarians assigned to St. Gilbert Parish by the diocese.

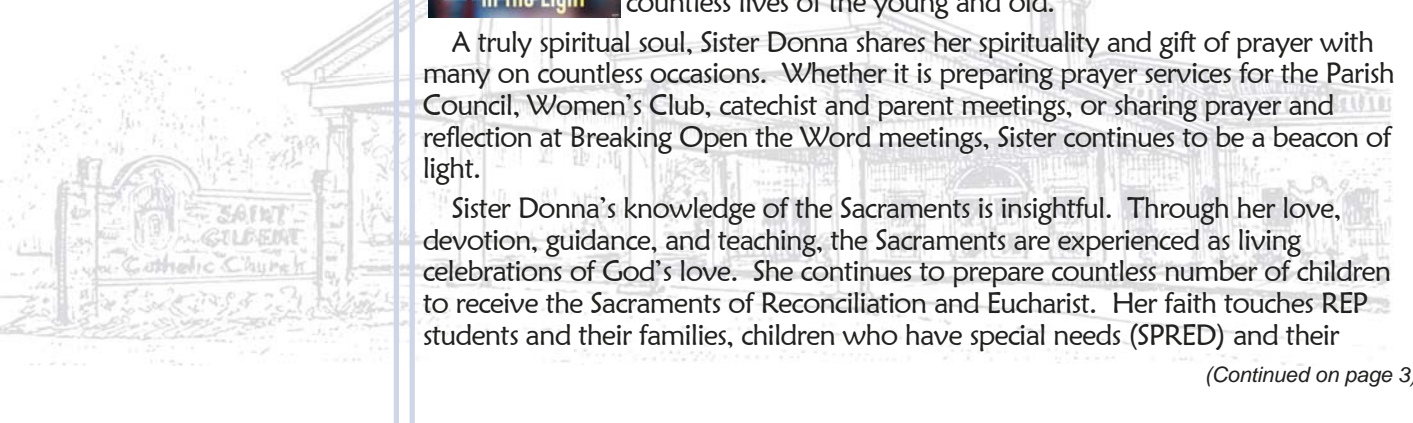

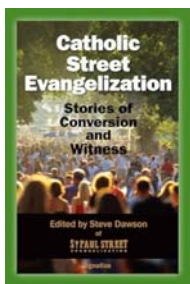

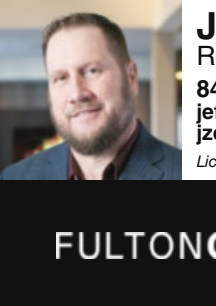
