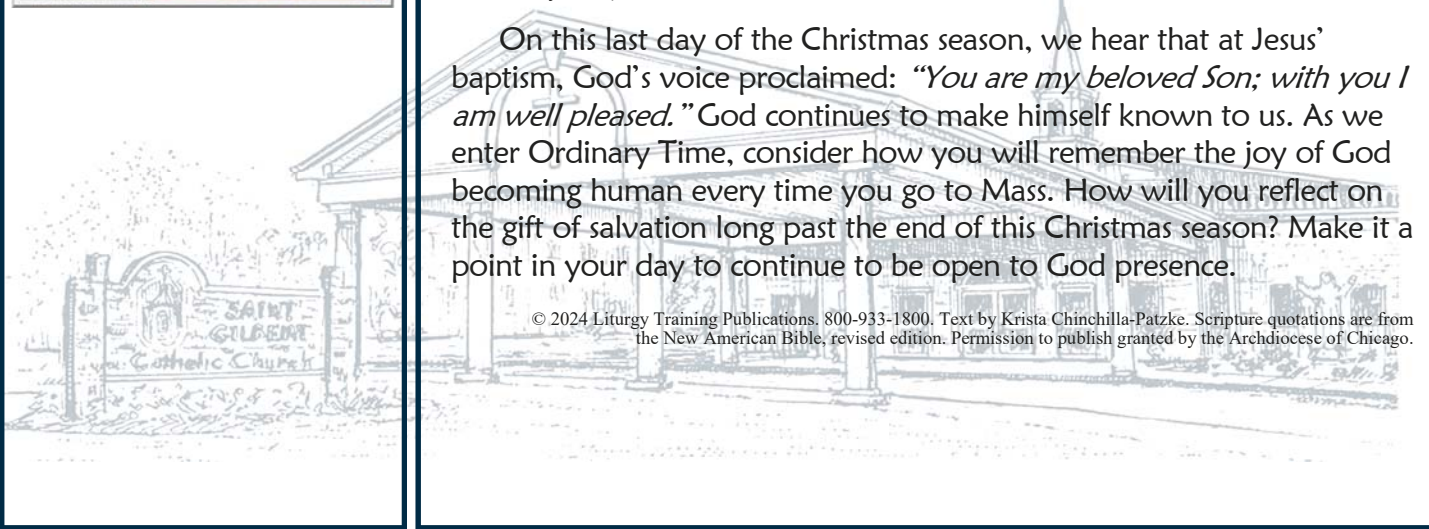
NEW CREATION

John the Baptist says: *“One mightier than I is coming. . . . He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.”* In other words, he will come to purify us. What a gift! Jesus did not need to be baptized, but in choosing to do so, he cleansed the waters and showed his solidarity with us so that we could be reconciled to God. In baptism, the Holy Spirit *“moves us to answer Christ’s call to holiness . . . we are asked to walk by the light of Christ and to trust in his wisdom,”* reads the United States Catholic Catechism for Adults. Spend time this week contemplating your baptism. On that day, you were welcomed into the Body of Christ and made a new creation. How does that inspire you?



On this last day of the Christmas season, we hear that at Jesus’ baptism, God’s voice proclaimed: *“You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.”* God continues to make himself known to us. As we enter Ordinary Time, consider how you will remember the joy of God becoming human every time you go to Mass. How will you reflect on the gift of salvation long past the end of this Christmas season? Make it a point in your day to continue to be open to God presence.

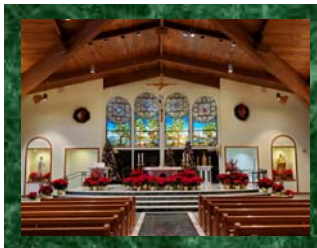
